



# Barons Bus Arena Protocol

## Revised 9/2/2020

The safety and health of anyone that enters the rink is our top priority and along with our staff we are asking that everyone self evaluate before coming to the Arena. Below is our protocol for all players, staff, parents and spectators when coming to Barons Bus Arena.

- All players, spectators, and coaches will be required to enter and exit at the designated doors. There will be one-way entrance and exits.
- All players, coaches, managers, and spectators must use the hand sanitizer upon entering arena.
- All players, spectators, and coaches must conduct daily symptom assessments; anyone experiencing symptoms must stay home as defined by the CDC.
- Players will not be allowed to enter the ice arena until 30 minutes before their scheduled game time and required to go immediately to their locker rooms (15 minutes if it is a practice). Players must exit locker rooms and arena 15 minutes after conclusion of game.
- **Spectators may not enter the rink until game time and must exit the rink immediately upon conclusion of the game. Spectators must wait for their players either in their cars or away from the arena doors and not congregate in front.**
- **Only two spectators per player will be allowed entry into the arena during games. This goes for home and away teams. Home team to supply both visitor and home lists to rink staff at least two days before scheduled games. All others will be asked to leave.**
- Face coverings must be worn at all times except when on ice surface as designed by the State of Ohio.
- Spectators must sit on designated X's marked on bleachers. Social distancing must be maintained at all times.
- Two locker rooms will be assigned per team.
- Locker rooms will be sanitized after each use.
- Players may not use showers.
- All players should bring individual water bottles.
- No spitting.
- Water fountains will not be available for use.
- Coaches/ team representatives must stay with their teams and ensure all guidelines are being followed at all times while at arena.
- There will be no congregating in lobby or arena at any time.
- High touch areas and restrooms will be cleaned and sanitized every hour.
- At the end of each day the arena will be deep cleaned and sanitized.

These are required by the State of Ohio.
